In 2005, the Firehouse was remodeled into an elegant, high-tech conference center and event venue. It now hosts business events, such as training seminars, management retreats, and executive meetings, as well as social events such as weddings and reunions.

The space offers a prep kitchen, multi-purpose banquet room, adaptable conference and meeting rooms, well-appointed executive board room, outdoor courtyard and balcony, ample parking, and much more. The facility is outfitted with state-of-the-art audio/visual equipment and wireless internet.
