Working for You



Newberry Police Department employs 33 sworn police officers and 5 civilian employees to serve a population of over 15,000 residents and students.

Newberry Police Department also has a reserve officer program. Currently there are nine reserve officers. These Reserve Officers volunteer their time to serve our community.

Officers are assigned to work in uniform patrol, training, investigations, juvenile operations, traffic enforcement, and narcotics.

Traffic Safety

Traffic Safety officers are responsible for coordinating the department's Traffic Safety Program. The goal of the traffic division is to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists in the City of Newberry through traffic safety and enforcement.

Investigations

- Detectives specialize in financial crimes, crimes against a person and property, homicide, juvenile crimes, and all other criminal offenses
- Process crime scenes for evidence
- Conduct examination in the department's own forensic laboratory
- Testify in court
- Undercover stings and surveillance
- Serve as liaisons to federal and state courts



Officers and Recruits receive a vast amount of training after their certification at the Criminal Justice Academy. Training is conducted by local instructors, State Agencies, Federal Agencies, and private vendors.
