**RESOLUTION:**

**Adoption of a Resolution Granting Consent for SCDOT  
to Perform Work to the College Street Bridge**

Mayor Senn proposed a Resolution for the SCDOT to begin work replacing the College Street Bridge as the City of Newberry has requested. It is stated that in order for all necessary work to begin the resolution must be passed.

City Manager Harvey stated that the Utility Director was able to research and locate documents verifying that the city utilities along College Street were in place before the bridge was constructed.

Utility Director Regier responded to an inquiry from Council concerning the timeline of the construction project.
