

**SPECIAL MEETING OF NEWBERRY CITY COUNCIL

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Senn called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Glasgow gave the invocation.

PRT:

Mayor Senn stated that at the March 8th Council Meeting, City Council voted unanimously to authorize the preparation of a contract for the design and construction of the proposed tennis complex. He then deferred to City Manager Harvey for an update of the process.

City Manager Harvey explained that the contract was sent to City Attorney Lake for a final review before it will be signed, but upon seeing no issues with the contract and once it is signed, the City would receive bids in July and anticipate construction to begin in the fall. City Manager Harvey gave an overall time line for the project and stated that he would give an update to Council in July once the bid process was completed. At that time the final design drawings would also be presented.

Councilman Boyd made a motion, seconded by Councilman Glasgow to sign the proposed contract once approved by the City Attorney. Mayor Senn declared the motion carried by a unanimous vote.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilman Goudelock made a motion to enter Executive Session for the purpose of discussing a personnel matter as outlined on the agenda. Councilman Boyd seconded the motion which was carried by a unanimous vote of City Council.


Following the Executive Session, a motion was made by Councilman Goudelock and seconded by Councilman DuBose to go back into open session. The motion was approved by a unanimous vote.


ADJOURNMENT
