

FACILITY RENTALS

Facilities are available for rental on a first-come first-served basis. Rental of a facility gives the renter priority ONLY to the facility rented and NOT to any other facility within a park. **For the full facility rental policy, contact the Department.**

Shelters	\$10 per 4 hour period \$30 per day PLUS \$10 Key Deposit
Pit Rental	\$15 + shelter rental fee
Short Notice Rentals	\$10 additional per facility (less than 24 hours)
Basketball Horseshoe courts	\$10/day per court
Baseball Softball Football Soccer fields	\$10/hour or \$50/day per field for tournament, practice or special event. \$25 deposit required
Lights	\$10/hour per court or field
Disc Golf	\$50/day Requires rental of Course shelter
