CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Senn called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Glasgow gave the invocation.

PUBLIC HEARING: Public Hearing on the Proposed FY2020-2021 Budget

Mayor Senn convened a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments concerning proposed changes to the zoning text, amending Article 9, Table 905 and Adding Section 907.7 for Digital Billboards.

**ORDINANCE: Second and Final Reading of Ordinance #2020-1009, to
Adopt the Budget and Levy Taxes for FY2020-2021**
