**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Senn called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Glasgow gave the invocation.

**ORDINANCE:                      First and Final Reading of Ordinance #2020-1010 requiring individuals to wear face coverings in certain circumstances and matters related thereto**

Mayor Senn offered up for reading, Ordinance #2020-2010 requiring individuals to wear face coverings in certain circumstances and matters related thereto. The ordinance requires individuals and staff in grocery stores, pharmacies and dollar stores to wear face coverings July 1-31, unless extended by council

The ordinance stresses the importance of facial coverings in an effort to reduce the spread of the Coronavirus and states the face covering shall simultaneously cover both the nostrils of the nose and the mouth at a minimum.

Any person who is unable to safely wear a face covering due to age, an underlying health condition, or is unable to remove the face covering without the assistance of others is exempt from the ordinance.

This ordinance only requires one reading.


