The space offers a prep kitchen, multi-purpose banquet room, adaptable conference and meeting rooms, well-appointed executive board room, outdoor courtyard and balcony, ample parking, and much more. The facility is outfitted with state-of-the-art audio/visual equipment and wireless internet.


