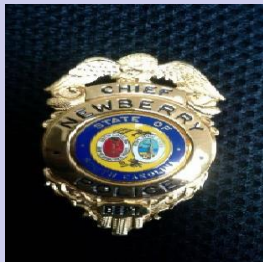

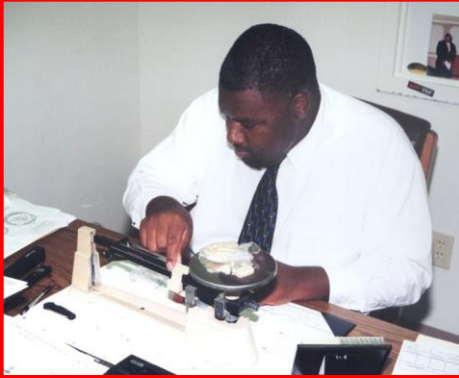

The Newberry Police Department employs 32 sworn officers and 5 civilian employees to serve nearly 15,000 citizens and college students.

Newberry Police Department also has a Reserve Officer Program. These "Citizen" officers dedicate their free time to serve our community.

Assigned officers receive specialized training in Supervision, Patrol Tactics, Training, Investigations, Juvenile Enforcement, Traffic Safety, Narcotics and K-9 Operations.

Traffic Safety

Traffic Safety Officers are responsible for coordinating the department's Traffic Safety Program. The goal of the Traffic Division is to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists traveling within the City of Newberry.

Investigations Division

Investigators specialize in financial crimes, juvenile offenses and crimes against persons and property.

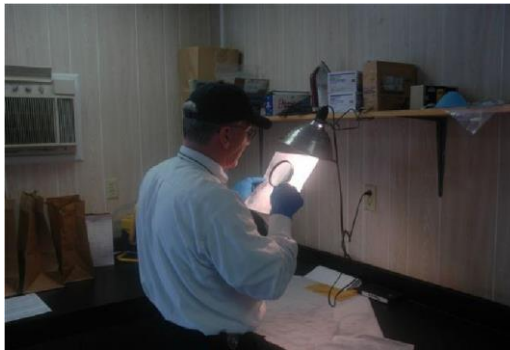
