CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kyzer called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M.

PUBLIC HEARING: Millage Override

Mayor Kyzer declared a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments concerning the proposed override of the State's requirement to limit millage increases to the amount of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) unless specifically overwritten by a vote of City Council. He noted that the allowable millage increase was 3.3 mills and the proposed budget would necessitate an approximate 8.5 millage increase.

There were no public comments related to the millage override recommendation and Mayor Kyzer declared the public hearing closed.

BUDGET: Millage Override for FY 2006-2007

Councilman Shealy made a motion, seconded by Councilman Goudelock, to authorize the override of the millage and to set the millage at a rate necessary to generate the amount of property tax revenue contained in the recommended fiscal 2006-2007 budget. Mayor Kyzer declared the motion carried following a unanimous vote of City Council members present.
