

# MOONLIGHT MOVIE NIGHT DRIVE IN RULES FALL 2020

**ONLY 50 VEHICLES ALLOWED. NO WALK-UP SPACES.**

**Should you or anyone in your party not follow distancing or masking guidelines you will be asked to leave.**

## **BEFORE YOU LEAVE FOR THE MOVIE:**

- **PARKING OPENS 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MOVIE**
  - All movies will begin at Sunset (SEE FACEBOOK EVENT PAGE FOR MOVIE TIMES). For the purpose of safely getting your vehicle into the lot we will only accept vehicle entry 30 minutes prior to the movie start, no earlier. **No entry will be permitted after the movie has begun.** If you choose to leave before the movie has ended you **MAY NOT re-enter with your vehicle.**
- **NO PETS ALLOWED:**
  - We love pets, however they are NOT permitted at our Moonlight Movie Nights events. This is for the safety of your pet, our patrons, and to mitigate waste cleanup.
- NO GRILLS, LASER POINTERS, ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, OR GLASS CONTAINERS.
- **PLEASE USE THE RESTROOM AT HOME PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL.** More restroom information under the guidelines section of this document.
- **BRING YOUR MASK.** Should you need to leave your vehicle for any reason you will be required to wear a mask or suitable face covering per SC Governor's order initiated on 8/3/2020 in regards to special events and entertainment venues.\*

## **ENTERING, EXITING, & PARKING IN THE LOT:**

- **LOT ENTRY IS AT THE CORNER OF FRIEND AND NANCE STREET ONLY.**
- Be courteous to those waiting in line and go to the end of the line. As they say in elementary school, "No Cutting Line!"

**Should you or anyone in your party not follow distancing or masking guidelines you will be asked to leave.**

- SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH
- ONE SPACE PER VEHICLE
  - The parking attendant will direct you to your space.
- High clearance vehicles on the last rows ONLY. Vehicles over 6 feet tall can NOT park in the paved lot. Parking attendants have the final say on where vehicles should park.
- **Use parking lights only when driving in to the “theater.”**
- When exiting, please be mindful of others as they pack up and leave the space. Please be patient and exit in an orderly fashion.
- PLEASE TAKE ALL TRASH WITH YOU- a trash cart will be placed at the vehicle exit for your convenience.
- **EXITING-** those parked in the **PAVED** lot will be asked to leave from **the Main Street Lot Exit**. Those parked in the **GRASS** lot will be asked to leave from the **Friend Street Lot Exit**.

## **AT YOUR SPACE:**

- **It is highly recommended that you watch the movie from inside your vehicle, with doors and windows shut for your safety and comfort** (you may run your vehicle for A/C). **Should you need to leave your vehicle for any reason you will be required to wear a mask or suitable face covering per SC Governor’s order 8/3/2020 in regards to special events and entertainment venues.\***
- Hatches must be no higher than the top of the vehicle.
  - **Please plan ahead to tie down your hatch should you use the trunk of your vehicle for seating.** Parking attendants will be monitoring for hatches that obscure the view of the movie screen.

**Should you or anyone in your party not follow distancing or masking guidelines you will be asked to leave.**

- YOU MAY NOT SIT ON TOP OF YOUR VEHICLE
  - Nothing (including radios, cups, heads, etc.) should be higher than the roof of your vehicle.
- **Turn off all vehicle lights when parked, including interior lights.**
  - Check your owner's manual regarding daytime running lights. It is your responsibility to make sure no light is emitted from your vehicle.
- There is no prohibition on running your engine during the movie unless it is extremely loud or has bad exhaust fumes. Please be considerate of your neighbors.
  - Consider putting your vehicle in Accessory Mode to tune in to FM 97.7 for sound. CHECK YOUR OWNERS MANUAL ABOUT BATTERY USE.
- **To practice distancing guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19 we ask that you remain in or your vehicle.**
  - Should you need to leave your vehicle for any reason you will be required to wear a mask or suitable face covering per SC Governor's order 8/3/2020 in regards to special events and entertainment venues.\*
  - **Please be aware of neighboring vehicles and be courteous to those around you.** This is a new world we're all living in and we must work together to protect each other.

## **WALK-IN SPACES ARE NO LONGER OFFERED:**

- Please note, per SC Governors orders set forth on August 3, 2020, as relates to special events and entertainment venues\*, should you exit your vehicle for any reason you MUST wear a mask or suitable cloth face covering. **Because of this we are no longer providing Walk-Up/In spaces.**

## **GUIDELINES:**

- Management reserves the right to have you move your vehicle to another location on the field. **Should you or anyone in your party not follow distancing and masking guidelines you will be asked to leave.**
- This is an outdoor event – please plan accordingly.
- NO SMOKING.
- **Masks are not mandatory when inside your vehicle, however one *must* be worn should you step outside your vehicle per SC Governor's order 8/3/2020 in regards to special events and entertainment venues.\***
- Wear shoes at all times.
- **Supervise your children at all times.**
- Please be courteous to others. Foul language will not be tolerated.
- **PLEASE USE THE RESTROOM AT YOUR HOME PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL.**
  - One portable toilet will be available to the end of the movie. This toilet should be considered for “emergency” use only.
  - You will be expected to wash your hands at the handwash station prior to entering and upon exiting the restroom. ONLY ONE PERSON or ONE GUARDIAN WITH ONE CHILD PER TRIP.
  - **Avoid the line and use the restroom at home prior to your arrival!**
  - The restroom will close following the final scene of the movie and start of the film credits. If you need to use the restroom after the movie you must do so at home.
