

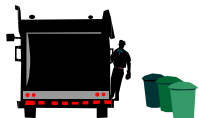
RESIDENTIAL WASTE COLLECTION



One (1) mobile cart shall be issued to each single-family household in the city. A monthly garbage service fee of seven dollars (\$7.00)



shall be charged for first cart included in the monthly utility bill of the residence. Additional roll carts shall be billed at a monthly rate of \$13.00 per cart. Failure to pay the prescribed garbage service fee will result in the termination of collection service by the city. The mobile cart will remain the property of the city for use of the household to which it is issued. Residents who damage mobile carts issued to them must pay for repairing the carts or purchase replacement carts from the city. Repair cost will represent the total cost of materials and labor in effect at the time of repair. The purchase price for replacement of a cart will be the actual cost of the cart to the city at the time of purchase by the resident. Carts that are damaged as the result of being emptied by city personnel shall be repaired or replaced at the city's expense. Collection will be suspended at any location at which a cart is missing or at which a cart is damaged to such an extent as to interfere with normal collection methods. If a cart is stolen, it is the responsibility of the resident to purchase a new cart. When the useful life of the original cart has expired as determined by the Director of Public Works, it will be replaced at no charge to the resident. Mobile carts are to be placed within 4-6 feet of the curbside with lid opening facing the street. Place cart out by 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection or the evening before and remove by 9:00 p.m. on the day of collection. If cart(s) are not out for collection when the truck comes by, your garbage will not be collected until the following week. **ONLY CITY ISSUED CARTS WILL BE EMPTIED!**



SHRUBBERY TRIMMINGS AND LIMBS

Shrubby trimmings and limbs may be placed at the front of the premises in the grass strip between the street and the sidewalk where such strips are available; otherwise they should be placed at the edge of the owner's property easily accessible to the city's collection personnel and equipment. **DO NOT** place shrubby and limbs near utility poles, under guy wires, near street signs, mailboxes, trees, fire hydrants, on water meters or in ditches. Shrubby trimmings and tree limbs should not be placed on the street or sidewalk where they may create a walking or traffic hazard. Tree limbs, tree trunks and other such debris cannot be longer than eight (8) feet in length, nor have diameters greater than twelve (12) inches. The property owner is responsible for notifying the public works department that such material has been placed where designated for collection. When the quantity to be collected warrants, a Special Pickup fee applies. The property owner will be responsible for removing tree limbs, tree trunks and other such debris which is greater than eight (8) feet in length and twelve (12) inches in diameter and when stumps are larger than can be picked up by the city's brush removal equipment. The property owner is responsible for removing tree limbs, tree trunks and other such debris which is generated as a result of a licensed private contractor or other individual who has been compensated for providing such service. The occupant should remove rubbish, ashes, or building materials not resulting from normal household uses from the premises thereof. **DO NOT MIX SHRUBBERY OR LIMBS WITH ANY OTHER TYPE YARD RUBBISH, METAL OR PAPER.**

LEAVES

Leaves are seasonal and may be placed at the front of the premises in the grass strip between the street and the sidewalk



where such strips are available; otherwise they should be placed at the edge of the owner's property easily accessible to the city's collection personnel and equipment. **DO NOT** place leaves near utility poles, under guy wires, street signs, trees, fire hydrants, in ditches or on water meters. **DO NOT MIX LEAVES WITH LIMBS, STICKS OR ANY OTHER TYPE RUBBISH, METAL OR PAPER;** Leaves should not be placed on the street where it may create a traffic hazard.

FURNITURE

Furniture such as chairs, sofas, mattresses, old wooden or wire fence with post, cardboard boxes, light metals such as swingsets, etc. need to be placed at the edge of the owner's property easily accessible to the city's collection personnel and equipment. The property owner will be responsible for notifying the public works department that such material has been placed where designated for collection. **DO NOT** place near utility poles, street signs, trees, fire hydrants or on water meters or in ditches.



APPLIANCES

Appliances and any metal type objects such as bicycles, hot water heaters, metal beds, air conditioners, lawn mowers etc. will be picked up on **FRIDAYS ONLY**. The property owner will be responsible for notifying the public works department that such material has been placed where designated for collection.

The collection, removal, and disposal of all waste from premises by the city shall be under the jurisdiction of the Director of Public Works. All fees and charges referenced in this article may be included in the monthly utility bill. Failure to pay the prescribed fees and charges will result in the termination of collection service by the city.

THINGS THE CITY DOES NOT PICK UP

- Tires
- Batteries
- Telephone Poles
- Chemicals/Fuel
- Soil or Dirt
- Creosote Crossties
- Car Parts
- Large Stumps or Root balls
- Any creosote treated wood

Effective July 1, 2011 SC Code of Laws passed

- Residents may not knowingly place or discard computers, monitors, printers, televisions, desktop, laptop, notebook/tablet computers, cell phones or DVD/VCR players in any waste stream that is to be disposed of in a solid waste landfill. These items can be taken at the Collection & Recycling Center Sites.

Special Pick-up Fee

Special Pick-ups exceeding five (5) cubic yards shall be assessed a fee, based on volume. Large quantities of limbs, brush, building material, household carpet, rugs, furniture, large house goods including but not limited to, box springs, couches. Chairs, tables, and metal goods generated by landlords, tenants, or residence. Any material from rental property cleanouts or evictions initiated by the property owner or his agent.

Code Enforcement Fee

Failure to comply with the requirements of this Section may result in the issuance of a notice of violation. Failure to abate the violation within 72 hours of receiving the citation shall result in mandatory removal of the prohibited material by City personnel. Charges for mandatory removals shall be billed at the rate set forth in the Code Enforcement Fee Schedule in this Section. The City reserves the right to add this fee to the property owner or tenants monthly utility bill. Failure to pay these charges may result in termination of municipal utility services, or other appropriate collection methods including legal action. Additionally, the City reserves the right to bill rental property owners directly.
