The City of Newberry is looking for a person that loves working outdoors and has a maintenance and/or landscaping background to join the Public Works Department - Street Maintenance team. Some work involves maintaining and operating various handheld and medium to light equipment including, but not limited to, tractor, backhoe, weed eater, front-end loader, lawn mower, and bush hog for general maintenance in the City. In this role, some days' tasks would include replacing street signs, cleaning and repairing storm drains, cleaning City buildings and/or parking lots, spreading dirt and painting. As a maintenance worker, you would be outside year-round ensuring the City's streets are maintained.

As a member of the Public Works department, some additional job functions will include: to respond to after-hours emergencies as needed, assist as a sanitation worker as needed, and apply herbicide with handheld or motorized equipment.

Normal working hours are 7am - 3pm Monday - Friday.

- High school diploma or GED with five (5) to eleven (11) months related experience.
- Ability to lift and/or carry weights up to one hundred pounds.
- Work in outside environment; ability to meet physical demands
- Valid SC driver's license.
