**CITY COUNCIL**

Mayor Senn invited PRT Director Scott Sawyer to come forward and review the bids and budget plans for the Newberry Recreation Complex.

Director Sawyer stated that on April 25, 2018, Newberry County received nine (9) bids from potential contractors. Based on a review of the bids submitted and review of contractor qualifications, Alliance Consulting Engineers, Inc. recommended that the contract for the City of Newberry Recreational Complex be awarded to the low bidder, Wiley Easton Construction Company, Inc. of Lexington, SC. Newberry County will fund the base bid of \$2,594,881.50 from the Capital Project Sales Tax (CPST). Upon the City's approval to accept Wiley Easton Construction Company's bid, the Newberry County Council will consider the same at its next scheduled meeting on Wednesday, May 16, 2018. Director Sawyer asked for City Council's approval to execute contract agreements with Wiley Easton Construction Company in order for construction to begin on the City of Newberry Recreational Complex, as approved by Newberry




County voters in the 2016 Capital Projects Sales Tax referendum that was on the general election ballot on November 8, 2016.
